NRA Registered Match

LOCATION: NRA Whittington Center, Raton, NM; 8 miles south of Raton on U.S. 64 (Mile 288.7). Follow the signs from the gate to the High Power Rifle Range. Call the Whittington Center about competitor housing, camping, and practice shooting (505) 445-3615.

RULES: Current NRA High Power Rules will apply. For safety and timeliness, brass policing in front of the firing line will only be permitted during pit changes and yard line changes.

COMPETITION OPEN TO: Any individual NRA member. Junior Competitors may be individual members of an NRA Affiliated Club in lieu of NRA membership. No adult non-NRA members may compete in this tournament. Foreign competitors need not be NRA members.

INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES: Entries in individual events will be made by using the attached Entry Form, accompanied by a check or money order for the full amount of the entry desired. NRA membership number must be recorded on the form. If payment does not accompany entry, you are not registered.

TEAM ENTRIES: Teams will consist of four firing members. An alternate, non-firing Captain and a non-firing Coach may also be named; or the Captain and Coach may be firing members of the team. A Team Captain must be named (Rule 12.1). Team representation: Club, Rule 2.11; Law Enforcement Agency, Rule 2.14; Service, Rule 2.13; State Association, Rule 2.12; or Junior, Rule 2.18. Pick up teams are encouraged but can shoot only for class awards. Stat office will assist in organizing teams.

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Squadding for individual matches will be issued by the Stat Office to competitors who check in at the Stat Office. No squadding will be issued on the firing line. A competitor who fails to obtain his squadding, or fails to be at the proper firing point when his relay is called may lose his privilege to compete in that event.

TEAM SQUADDING: Announced on the range. One team member will go to the pits and pull a target assigned to him by the pit officer. Point 1 will score for Point 3 and Point 3 will score for Point 1; 5 for 7; 7 for 5, etc. If there are an odd number of teams, the last three teams at the right of the line will exchange scorers so that no scorer scores for his own team. Slow fire stages will be fired by pairs in a time limit of 27 minutes. For rapid fire stages, preparation periods for the second shooter will be during scoring for the first shooter.

COMPETITORS WILL PULL TARGETS AND SCORE: Target pullers may only be hired through the Stat Office. Competitors failing to meet their scoring or target pulling duties may be disqualified from the match.

IDENTIFICATION: NRA membership and classification cards must be shown before any squadding will be issued.

CLASSIFICATION: NRA classification will be used in all matches other than the LEG Match. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6 (assigned classification), or 19.2 (temporary classification).

RIFLES & SIGHTS: Service Rifle (Rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3) or Match Rifle (Rules 3.3, 3.3.1) or NRA Any Sight Match Rifle (Rule 3.3.4) Competitors using 3.3.4 rifles will shoot in a separate division of classes and will not be eligible for medallions nor for awards outside the division.

EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR (ECI) – Rule 3.21: An Empty Chamber Indicator is required in all NRA High Power Rifle competition to indicate the bolt is open and the chamber is empty. The Empty Chamber Indicator, stock number CT17500, is required but may be modified as necessary to extend into the chamber. The ECI, when inserted into the rifle, must extend into the otherwise empty chamber. ECIs may be purchased from the Stat office for \$1.00 each.

TARGETS: 200 yds, SR; 300 yds, SR-3; 600 yds, MR-1; 800 yds, 900 yds, 1000 yds, LR.

CATEGORIES & CLASSES FOR AWARDS: There will be no categories in any match. In the Palma match, there will be two divisions, Service Rifle & US Palma Rifle. Divisions will be combined within a class if there are fewer than Four competitors in a division.

AWARD DISPOSITION: The awards will be Cash paid at the conclusion of the match. Competitors who wish to have Blackinton Medals or NRA Award Coupons should request a form from the stat office. There must be four or more entries in a class for one award, eight or more for two awards, etc. Team Match, one award for every two teams. Fun Match, one award for every three shooters without regard to class.

AGGREGATE AWARD SCHEDULE: REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Winner: NRA Regional Gold Medallion & cash

2nd: NRA Regional Silver Medallion & cash

3rd: NRA Regional Bronze Medallion & cash

Special Awards: High Senior (Rule 2.2.1), High Woman, High Junior (Rule 2.3)

MATCH RESULTS: Match results will be printed and available to competitors at the Stat Office one hour after shooting is completed each day. If competitors do not pick up results at the match, they may download results at www.nmrifleshooting.com approximately ten days after the match. Match results will not be mailed to any competitors.

REGISTRATION FEES: All competitors must pay with NRA Award Points, check or cash. Receipts will be available on request. (Fees include: NRA \$9/competitor, \$5/team; NRA Whittington Center \$10/day/competitor.)

Make checks payable to **NMSSA-HPR**.

FRIDAY: \$25 PALMA MATCH

\$40 TEAM MATCH

(\$10/COMPETITOR)

Note: There will be a \$10/Competitor surcharge for those shooters who shoot in the team match but do not shoot in the Palma match to cover NRA Whittington Center Range Fees.

SATURDAY: \$45 INDIVIDUAL MATCH

(Includes aggregate, Matches 1-5)

SUNDAY: \$20 LEG MATCH

\$20 FUN MATCH

JUNIOR FEES: For all matches other than the LEG Match, one half the above amounts.

LATE ENTRY SERVICE FEE: \$10 after June 18, 2007 (no late fee for active military). Late entries may be accepted up to the limit of range capacity. No competitors will be squadded by telephone.

CANCELLATION POLICY: Fees paid by those unable to attend will be refunded, minus a \$10 service fee, upon request providing cancellation is made prior to the match. There will be no refund for those who do not notify the match director of cancellation prior to the beginning of the match.

PALMA

07:30 FRIDAY JUNE 20, 2008

3 RELAYS

STAGE 1: Unlimited sighting shots and 15 shots for record, prone, slow fire, 800 yards, in 22 minutes.

STAGE 2: 2 sighting shots and 15 shots for record, prone, slow fire, 900 yards, in 22 minutes.

STAGE 3: 2 sighting shots and 15 shots for record, prone, slow fire, 1000 yards, in 22 minutes.

2007 HIGH POWER RIFLE 4 MAN TEAM REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

FRIDAY, JUNE 20, 2008

Starts Approximately One Hour After the Completion of Palma Match

4 RELAYS

All competitors will fire at a given yard line before any competitors fire at the next yard line.

2 sighting shots & 10 shots for record, standing, slow fire, 200 yards.

2 sighting shots, 10 shots for record, prone from standing, rapid fire, 300 yards, in 70 seconds.

2 sighting shots & 10 shots for record, prone, slow fire, 600 yards.

3 RELAYS

Match 1: 2 sighting shots & 20 shots for record, standing, slow fire, 200 yards, SR target, Rule 5.12. All competitors will fire Match 1 before anyone fires Match 2.

Match 2: 2 sighting shots & 20 shots for record, sitting or kneeling from standing, rapid fire, 200 yards, SR target, Rule 5.8 or 5.10

Match 3: 2 sighting shots & 20 shots for record, prone from standing, rapid fire, 300 yards, SR-3 target, Rule 5.6

Match 4: 2 sighting shots & 20 shots for record, prone, slow fire, 600 yards MR-1 target, Rule 5.6.

Match 5: Regional Championship: Aggregate Scores fired in Matches 1, 2, 3, & 4.

SERVICE RIFLE LEG MATCH & NMSSA FUN MATCH

07:30 SUNDAY, JUNE 22, 2008

3 RELAYS

It is not necessary to enter the NRA matches to fire in this event.

The Leg Match and Fun Match will be run concurrently. You may enter both of these matches if you are shooting a Service Rifle.

1. LEG MATCH OPEN TO: Any citizen of the United States, 16 years of age or older.
2. RULES: This match is governed by the rules prescribed by the National Board for the Promotion of Rifle Practice (NBPRP). (See AR 920-30/AR 350-6/AR 672-5-1)
3. ENTRY LIMITS: None
4. ENTRIES: To complete the OFFICIAL entry, the NBPRP Entry & Score Card must be obtained from the Range Officer Sunday morning.
5. ENTRY FEES: \$20 per person. (Leg Match: \$10 CMP and \$10 Whittington range fees. Fun Match: \$10 for awards and \$10 Whittington range fees.)
6. AUTHORIZED ARMS: Service Rifle as prescribed for use in the Leg Matches at the National Matches. Fun Match: Service Rifle and NRA Match Rifle (3.3, 3.3.1) or Any Sight Match Rifle (3.3.4)
7. AMMUNITION: Any safe ammunition. No flat base bullets may be used at 600 yards.
8. COURSE OF FIRE: NATIONAL MATCH COURSE: 50 shots, no sighting shots.

Stage 1: 10 shots for record, standing, slow fire, 200 yards SR target. Time: 10 min. The sling must be attached to the rifle in the parade position, but it must not be used for support.

Stage 2: 10 shots for record, sitting or kneeling from standing, rapid fire, 200 yards, SR target. Time: 60 seconds.

Stage 3: 10 shots for record, prone from standing, rapid fire, 300 yards, SR-3 target. Time: 70 seconds.

Stage 4: 20 shots for record, prone, slow fire, 600 yards MR-1. Time: 20 min.

9. AWARDS: Credit towards Distinguished designation and appropriate Excellence in Competition badges provided by AR 622-10 and AR 672-5-1. Awards for the Fun Match will be given to 1st place, 4th place, 7th place, etc. without regard to NRA classification or rifle type.

SPECIAL NOTE: You must send us a notarized copy of the CMP's "Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement" in order to compete in the Leg Match.
